Turing at a Glance

Turing company accounts are built for teamwork: you join by invitation and manage the work as a team with role-appropriate permissions. Knowledge lives in the system, not in a person.

THREE CORE VALUES FOR YOU

- 01 Join by invitation**
Tap the invitation link; setup takes minutes.
- 02 Role-based permissions**
Who sees and approves what is clear from the start; 2FA protects you.
- 03 Shared flow**
Requests, offers and the calendar are visible to the team; no job goes unowned.

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What is Turing?

Turing is a B2B marketplace that brings event organizers and service providers together on a single platform. Requests, offers and digital contracts move through one flow; every step of the process is on record.

Payment and collection status is monitored through the financial tracking screen in the app. Service fees are settled between the parties under their own agreed terms — Turing does not act as an intermediary for these payments.

TRANSPARENT REVENUE MODEL

Turing earns revenue from only two sources: a tiered commission from organizers per completed transaction (15% down to 5%) and an optional subscription for service providers (Free / PRO / PREMIUM). There are no hidden fees of any kind.

Artist access through managers and booking agencies
- 02 Technical Production**
Sound, lighting, stage and LED systems
- 03 Venues**
Concert halls, open-air spaces, hotels, studios

Group accommodation for artists and crews
- 05 Transport**
VIP transfers, crew transport, equipment logistics
- 06 Operations**
Security, front-of-house and field staff

Real Problems from the Field

This file starts from your agenda: on the left, a problem the industry faces every day; on the right, its counterpart on Turing.

PROBLEM	WITH TURING
1 Job knowledge lives on the boss's phone: which offer got what answer, which date is optioned — the team can't know without asking.	Incoming requests, sent offers and the calendar are visible to the team on the same screen. Knowledge lives in the system, not in a person.
2 Everyone having access to everything is a problem — and so is no one seeing anything: the permission balance never settles.	Role-based access; who views, who sends offers, who approves is defined from the start. 2FA protects the accounts.
3 Some jobs get chased by two people at once while others go unowned.	Because the request flow is shared and visible, who is handling what is clear; duplicated work and ownerless requests disappear.
4 Professionals serving multiple companies drown in account and app clutter.	With one Turing account you join multiple companies and switch with a single tap; your role is separate in each.

Example flow: a management assistant's Tuesday

The steps follow the real platform flow; names are illustrative.

- 1 You open the app in the morning: two booking requests came in overnight, one for the artist you are responsible for.
- 2 You review the request details; since it is above the budget threshold requiring your manager's approval, you prepare the offer as a draft.
- 3 Your manager sees the draft on their own screen and approves with one tap; the offer goes to the organizer.
- 4 In the afternoon the organizer's counter-offer lands; the correspondence continues in the same flow and nothing is lost while you are on duty.
- 5 By day's end the calendar and process are current: the teammate taking over tomorrow doesn't have to ask where to pick up.

What Does Turing Offer You?

Turing company accounts are built for teamwork. The company owner invites you, your role is set, and from that moment offers, contracts and event operations run as a team from one place.

01 Fast onboarding by invitation

Tap the invitation link sent by your company admin and your account joins the company in the Turing app; setup takes minutes.

03 Shared request and offer flow

Requests received and offers sent are visible to the team; who is handling which job is clear, so duplicated work and information gaps disappear.

05 In-app communication

Organizer and supplier correspondence stays on the platform; nothing is lost between e-mail and messaging apps.

02 Role-based permissions

Not everyone sees everything: admin, member and viewer roles make it clear from the start who sees and approves what. Two-factor authentication (2FA) protects your account.

04 Shared calendar and operations

Event dates, delivery steps and process status in one calendar; on site and in the office, everyone works from the same information.

06 Multi-company support

If you work at more than one company, switch between them with a single Turing account; your role is defined separately in each.

How It Works



01

Receive the invitation

Your company admin sends you an invitation through Turing.



02

Install the app and join

The invitation link takes you to the right screen via the App Store or Google Play.



03

Take on your role

Your permissions are set automatically by role; relevant work lands on your panel.



04

Manage together

Offers, contracts and event operations proceed as a team from one place.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Is being a team member paid?

A. No. Team membership is part of the company account; there is no extra charge to you.

Q. an I work at more than one company?

A. Yes. With a single account you can be a member of multiple companies and switch between them inside the app.

Q. My invitation link is not working — what should I do?

A. The link takes you straight to the invitation screen if the app is installed, or to the App Store / Google Play if it is not. If the problem persists, ask your admin to renew the invitation.
